Secure infrastructure for the church. Even where it's hunted.

One app for a hidden house church and a megachurch online — with no accounts, no company in the middle, and no central list to seize.

— THE PROBLEM

An app shouldn't be able to get someone arrested.

WHERE THE CHURCH IS HUNTED

The app is the evidence.

A synced contact list, a group chat, a cloud backup — one seized phone hands over **everyone who gathered**, tied to real names and phone numbers a government can demand.

The church's life sits on tools it **doesn't control**.

EVERYWHERE ELSE

You're renting your flock.

The same mainstream tools **mine the data, charge per seat, and can change the rules overnight** — run by companies that don't share your mission and hold the off-switch.

— WHY IT'S DIFFERENT

Not a platform. A protocol.

Like email — an open standard anyone can run. No company in the middle, nothing central to seize, and the church holds its own keys.



Nothing to seize

Each church's data lives on its own hardware. There's no company database to raid, subpoena, or breach.



No phone or email

An identity is just a name your church knows — nothing tying a believer to a SIM or a real-name account.



Offline & sealed

The whole Bible and your fellowship live on the device. The member list is encrypted — not there for anyone to read.

— WHAT IT IS

One home for the whole church — not a dozen apps.



Read

A complete offline Bible — 1,000+ translations, readable with no signal at all. Plans and reflection.



Gather

Your church, privately: groups, prayer, serving rotas, a shared calendar, care — with safeguarding built in.



Share

Encouragement, sermons, events, and optional giving records — treasurer's tools kept private.

Runs anywhere — from a **£35 box** in a home to a **megachurch's own servers**.

The same open software serves twenty people no one outside can see, and twenty thousand with their own branding — free, and self-hosted or hosted.

— WHO IT'S FOR

Equip the church — without becoming its weak point.



Organisations serving the persecuted church

Put secure, offline-ready infrastructure into believers' hands. You never hold their keys — so you can't be the door that's forced open. Open-source and auditable; free but for cheap hardware.



Churches, large and small

A private home for your people — self-hosted or hosted, your brand and your rules, with no per-seat bill. Get off Big Tech and keep your congregation's trust.



And the two meet here. A church in the free world can run a node that quietly serves believers in a hostile one — carrying the cost and the risk of the infrastructure, while never holding their keys or seeing inside. The body, wired together.



Let's put it in the hands of the church.

If you serve the church

Let's scope a pilot with the believers you already reach — a field deployment, a security review, a conversation.

If you are the church

Start a church free, in an afternoon: set it up, share a joining code, and your people are in.
